

## DEFINITIONS

Nasdaq-100 Monthly Net Credit Collar 95-100 Index	The Underlying Index measures the performance of a risk managed income strategy that holds the underlying stocks of the NASDAQ 100 Index and applies an options collar strategy (i.e., a mix of short (sold) call options and long (purchased) put options) on the NASDAQ 100 Index. The Underlying Index specifically reflects the performance of the component securities of the NASDAQ 100 Index, combined with a long position in the 5% out-of-the-money (“OTM”) put options and a short position in at-the-money (“ATM”) call options, each corresponding to the value of the portfolio of stocks in the NASDAQ 100 Index. The options collar seeks to generate a net-credit, meaning that the premium received from the sale of the call options will be greater than the premium paid when buying the put options.
Nasdaq 100 Index	The Nasdaq-100 Index includes 100 of the largest domestic and international non-financial companies listed on The Nasdaq Stock Market based on market capitalization. The Index reflects companies across major industry groups including computer hardware and software, telecommunications, retail/wholesale trade and biotechnology. It does not contain securities of financial companies including investment companies.
Annualized Volatility	The annualized standard deviation of the daily returns of the security using the closing levels of the index during the 22 index-day period preceding that day.
Beta	Measures the volatility of the Fund price relative to the volatility in the market index and can also be defined as the percent change in the price of the Fund given a 1% change in the market index. A beta below one suggests that the Fund was less volatile than the market benchmark.
Sharpe Ratio	Measures the return for each unit of risk. The risk free rate is subtracted from the mean return and is divided by the standard deviation of returns.

QRMI engages in options trading. An option is a contract sold by one party to another that gives the buyer the right, but not the obligation, to buy (call) or sell (put) a stock at an agreed upon price within a certain period or on a specific date. A collar strategy involves holding shares of the underlying stock while simultaneously buying put options and selling call options against that holding. QRMI writes covered call index options on and purchases put options on the Nasdaq 100 Index. By selling covered call options, the fund limits its opportunity to profit from an increase in the price of the underlying index above the exercise price. By purchasing put options, in return for the payment of premiums, the Fund may be protected from a significant decline in the price of the Nasdaq 100 Index if the put options become in the money (Nasdaq 100 closes below the strike price as of the expiration date); but during periods where the Nasdaq 100 Index appreciates, the Fund will underperform due to the cost of the premiums paid. A liquid market may not exist for options held by the Fund. While the fund receives premiums for writing the call options, the price it realizes from the exercise of an option could be substantially below the indices current market price.
